What began in one school serving 76 young people has grown to serving over 3,500 youth annually at 102 programs statewide. In that time, we have faced challenges and overcame them, always keeping our youths' needs front and center.

Over the past year and a half, we listened and responded to the changing needs of our youth. Our Specialists worked all hours to help our young people overcome the additional barriers they were facing and continued to provide them with a sense of purpose and belonging. 


